### **The Natural Wealth of Ukraine**

Ukraine is rich in natural resources: sulphur, coal, iron ore, nickel, manganese, uranium, building materials, mercury ore. The reserves of sulphur and mercury ore are ones of the largest in the world. Ukraine has more than 5 % of the world's reserves of iron ore. There are also oil and natural gas deposits but their reserves aren't large but coal deposits are large in our country. Coal is mined in the Donetsk and Lviv-Volyn basins. The Donetsk basin is located on the territory of Donetsk and Luhansk regions. Donetsk and Luhansk regions are the largest industrial and mining-metallurgical complexes of Europe. Uranium ore is mined in Dnipro and Kropyvnytskyi regions. Ukraine is also rich in building materials — wood, chalk, granite, marble, marl, sandstone. The largest reserves of granite are found in Zhytomyr region. The largest deposits of oil are concentrated in Poltava, Sumy, Chernihiv regions. The largest industrial cities of Ukraine are Kyiv, Dnipro, Kharkiv, Donetsk, Luhansk, Odesa, Mykolaiv, Kherson and other cities. Heavy industry, light industry, agriculture and other industries are developed in Ukraine.
